# Using OSEU in your lesson plans

- When doing lessons plans you can adjust them to the grades you are teaching.
- Ex. Wichahpi Wo'oyake Star Knowledge for 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> grade
- Objectives: Actively Listen
- Understand and follow a simple command in Lakota
- Standards: Identify SINGLE WORD or simple PHRASE.
- Resources: Twinkle Twinkle Little Star, From Earl Bullheads CD 1
- Lakota Children's Songs
- Activities: Teaching the Lakota word for Star, showing a star and saying
- ▶ Le Wichahpi kin-This is a star, having children repeat after you.
- Having children draw, color, and cut out a star

### Adjusting Lesson plans;

You can adjust your lessons plans to any grade, using the OSEU standards, on any topic.

"Le Wichapi Kin" can be made more in-depth according to your students knowledge of the Lakota language.

Games or drawing can be applied using the Lakota language

- Ex. K-1, pin the Sinte (tail) on the Wichapa (star).
  - 2-3, singing Twinkle Little Star in Lakota
  - 4-6, Working on the Star Boy story, having students recognize Lakota words. Could have children do a skit.
  - 7-8 coloring a star quilt pattern, making a Star Quilt wall hanging.
  - 9-12, Making a Star pattern to fit throw pillow coverings.

- Wayawa Cik'ala.com Is a website I use often. It has short videos all in Lakota. After watching a video we then go through which words they recognize, and practice the words.

# Lowan-Sing

- You can look up any type of Lakota song on Youtube.
- ▶ I have found that singing works well especially for the younger grades, they like to sing together and act out their songs.
- ▶ I have found that if you have them sing the number song and hold up their fingers and count along they remember the numbers better, as not just memorizing the song.
- ▶ We have the students sing the Flag song in the mornings when we have in school classes. As we are Zooming I will have them now and then. We are going to work on Silent Night in Lakota on Zoom as Christmas is coming up.
- ▶ I also play hand game songs, so they will remember them for when we can get together and Hand Games again. I also play the Wacipi Songs and show them Grand Entry of different Wacipis.
