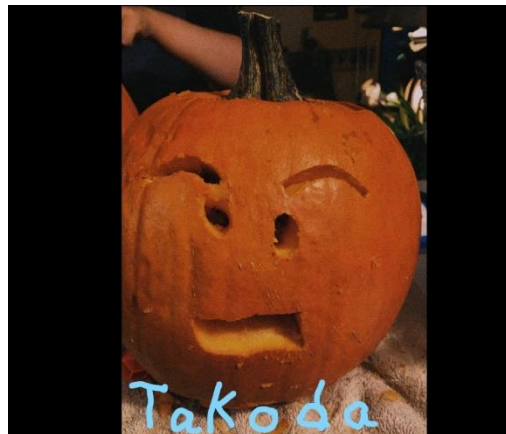

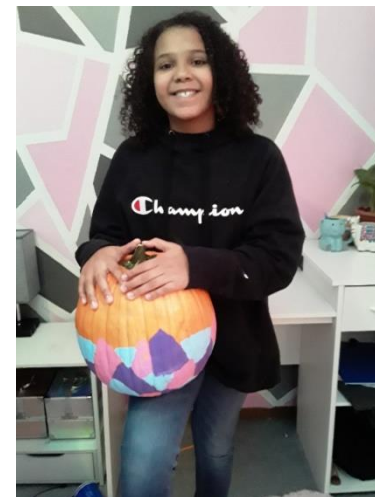
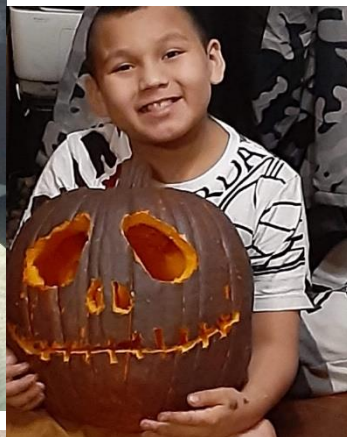

School Improvement

- 4-year plan for school improvement. We are on year 2.
 - Comprehensive Needs Assessment with Root Cause Analysis
 - Comprehensive School Improvement meetings monthly with a state representative.
 - We have 3 goals for the 4 years:
 - Improve cross-grade and building curriculum alignment
 - Improve lesson planning in planbook to include current state standards, objectives, instruction strategies (engagement), materials & technology, and assessment.
 - Increase use of engaging strategies for students in class and online.

 - **At C-EB Title IIA funds are fully used to hire 2 (or 3 if money allows) Elementary teachers to reduce sizes of classes.**

Title IV A- SS.AE (Student Support and Academic Enrichment) Grant

- This grant has 3 parts:
 - Provide all students with access to a **well rounded education** -- 60%
 - Improve school conditions for student learning to create a **healthy and safe school environment** – 36%
 - Improve the **use of technology** in order to improve the academic achievement and digital literacy of all students. – 4%

Well Rounded Education

- **After School Activities**
 - Archery, Walking Club, Science Club, Newspaper Club
 - Handgames, piano lessons, robotics, and tutoring
- **Science activities**
 - SD Discovery Center contract
 - Online activities in science



Safe and Healthy Children Technology Support

- **Social Worker**
 - Works on improving attendance
 - Helps with activities, travel for homeless students
 - Supplies to support social worker
- **TIE Conference registration and travel**

SEL (Social Emotional Learning) grant

- **Positive Action 3-year grant. We are on year 3.**
 - New materials for teaching SEL
 - Word of the Week and counseling activities for counseling class
 - Activities for every grade and classroom
 - Professional development including book studies on SEL topics
 - Parent activity game nights
 - After school small group “Friendship Group” activities
- **Our goals are to:**
 - Decrease chronic absenteeism
 - Increase number of lessons in SEL that students are exposed to
 - Decrease behavior incidents
