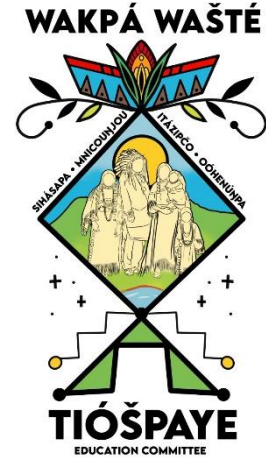


Cheyenne-Eagle Butte Braves
