BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS INSPECTIONS

The Board and Superintendent will provide schools that are safe from hazards, sanitary, properly equipped, lighted and ventilated and esthetically suited to promoting the goals of the schools.

The Superintendent and each school principal will be responsible for the general safe operations of the buildings and grounds.

Each school principal will have responsibility for the school facility and grounds under his or her charge. Principals will carry on a continuous inspection of all buildings, equipment, playgrounds and playground apparatus to discover conditions that may be dangerous to the health, safety or comfort of the students or staff. The superintendent and principal will supervise the custodial staff of the school in maintaining an adequate program of school care and maintenance.

All employees, however, are encouraged to report promptly to the principal of the school any defects to the building or equipment that could prove injurious to the comfort, health or safety of the students and staff.

Violations to the fire protection laws and other safety hazards will be reported to the Superintendent and corrected to ensure the well-being of the students, staff and the general public on school property.
