RELATIONS WITH PARENTS ORGANIZATIONS

The Board is aware of the constructive role, which the parent-teacher groups can play in the school system. The effective leadership provided by these organizations is valuable to the improvement of educational programs and community support of the schools. The Board will offer these groups its full cooperation, and urges parents, teachers, and administrators to become enthusiastic participants.

The Wakpa Waste' Tiospaye (parent/stakeholder) Committee may be of service to the schools in each area of the district by fostering community undertakings, encouraging social activities, working for needed legislation, discovering and reporting facts which lead to community or school improvements, studying school problems, supporting school projects, and cooperating with other community agencies.

Each school may set up its own form of parent/stakeholder committee. Before official recognition, their organizational plan and rules of operation must be approved by the Board.
