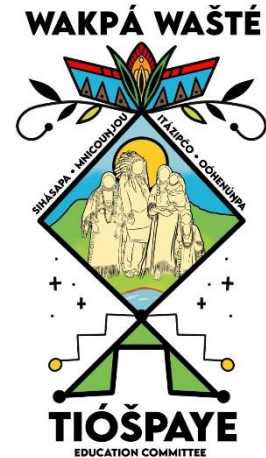


# Cheyenne-Eagle Butte Braves
