Re: Dissemination of April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2021 Parent & Tribal Input Meeting Information

On April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2021, the Eagle Butte Public School District 20-1 held an Indian Parent Education Committee & Tribal Input Meeting via zoom and at an in-person physical location to accommodate the attendance preferences of all stakeholders. The public meeting and access information was published in the West River Eagle, posted on the District website, and delivered through a parent mailing. Meeting information was extended to the CRST Chairman, CRST Tribal Ed. Chair, and the CRST Tribal Ed. Director. In attendance were four Indian Parent Education Committee Members, one school administrator, one business manager, and Dr. Cherie Farlee, CRST Tribal Education Agency Director.

Superintendent Four Bear shared a presentation of the recent Tribal Consultation Presentation which included School Programming Updates, Native American Participation Data, and School Funding Updates. School updates included information on the 2019-2020 State Report Card through the South Dakota Department of Education (SDDoE), Comprehensive Support Strategies, and the Career & Technical Education (CTE) Current Local Needs Analysis (CLNA) process and potential outcomes for the growth and development of CTE programming and other course offerings. Additionally, shared and reviewed was the proposed application for Title VI funding.

The meeting included 2 sections for stakeholders to provide input on all topics for school improvement and the proposed Title VI application. Four Bear extended availability and means for submitting input via text message, email, phone call, or in person via the Upper Elementary Business Office at the convenience of all stakeholders.

Input was provided by Committee Member, Candace Lee; Committee Member, Rhea LeCompte; Committee Member, M.J. Cook; and by Dr. Cherie Farlee as attendees of the meeting. Each expressed their appreciation for the organization of the information, materials, and website access to programming documents and other resources. Each attending member expressed their support of the proposed Title VI application with no changes. The meeting concluded with adjournment.
