- Upper Elementary: Monday Thursday; all students will attend every day
- Lunch: Closed; no outside food or drinks due to the mitigation efforts to slow or stop the spread of coronavirus
- K-12 Virtual Instruction: Daily
- No student check outs between 7:45 8:30 am & 2:45 3:30 pm; beginning & end of day procedures will be in effect, check outs other than the times listed will need prior notification
- K-12 end of day student pick up: Please follow the CDC, CRST Guidelines, BIE Return to Learn! Plan and South Dakota Starting Well; 6 feet or more and wear a mask
- Buildings will be closed to parents/guardians due to the COVID-19 global pandemic and mitigation efforts to slow and stop the spread of Coronavirus
